Do you want to use the certificate outside New Zealand?

When you need to use a New Zealand certificate in another country, you might be asked to get the document apostilled or authenticated. Apostilles and authentications are certificates that prove the signature, stamp or seal on a document is genuine.

If you want to use the certificate overseas, go to govt.nz/authentications to find more information.

Do you need a certificate or a copy of the record?

You can order a certificate or a copy of the record. A certificate is a legal official document. A copy of the record contains more information than a certificate and is usually used for research purposes.

Are you researching family history?

If you want to order a certificate or a copy of the record for a historical death, you can do this at <u>bdmhistoricalrecords.dia.govt.nz</u>.

A historical death is the death of a person who:

- died 50 years ago or more, or
- was born 80 years ago or more
