You can apply for a pre-adoptive birth certificate if you:

- · are aged 20 or older, and
- were born and adopted in New Zealand.

What is a pre-adoptive birth certificate?

A pre-adoptive birth certificate shows details about your birth parents. Under the Adult Adoption Information Act 1985, people aged 20 and over, who were born and adopted in New Zealand, have a right to apply for their pre-adoptive birth certificate.

A pre-adoptive birth certificate will usually contain the following information:

- · your birth name
- the name, age and birthplace of your birth mother and birth father (if known)
- your adoptive name
- · the names of your adoptive parents, and
- the date of your final Adoption Order and the court or magistrate who made this order.

Your pre-adoptive birth certificate will be stamped with 'Issued for the Purposes of the Adult Adoption Information Act 1985'. This is to differentiate this from your post-adoptive birth certificate, which has your adoptive name and the names of your adoptive parents.

If your parent has placed a veto

Your birth parent can place a veto if you were adopted before 1 March 1986. You will still receive your pre-adoptive birth certificate, but it will not include your birth parent's name, age or birthplace. In this situation, your certificate will be sent directly to you.

A veto lasts for a 10 year period unless it is removed or renewed for a further 10 years by your birth parent.

Services a counsellor or social worker can offer

A counsellor or social worker can give you advice and support about tracing and contacting your birth parent(s).

An Oranga Tamariki Adoption Service social worker can:

- · tell you how to access information that may be on your adoption file, and
- help you trace and contact a living birth parent, and find out if a birth parent has died.

How to order your pre-adoptive birth certificate

You must complete two forms:

- BDM451 Request for Pre-adoptive New Zealand Birth Certificate (pages 7–8 of this application), and
- BDM130 General Identity Declaration (pages 9–10 of this application).

If you were adopted before 1 March 1986 and live in New Zealand

Under the Adult Adoption Information Act 1985, your pre-adoptive certificate will be sent to your nominated counsellor if:

- · you live in New Zealand, and
- there is no veto in place.

You can nominate either:

- an Oranga Tamariki Adoption Service social worker, or
- a community based independant counsellor who has been approved by Oranga Tamariki Adoption Service under the Adult Adoption Information Act 1985.

A list of approved counsellors is included on pages 3-5 of this form.

If you nominate an independant counsellor, contact them before completing your application form to confirm they are available.

If you nominate an Adoption Service social worker, you do not need to contact them in advance. They will contact you once you have received your certificate.

You can meet your nominated counsellor or social worker in person or by telephone.

If you were adopted before 1 March 1986 and live overseas

You pre-adoptive certificate will be sent directly to you.

Oranga Tamariki Adoption Service offer advice and support for people who were adopted in New Zealand and live overseas.

If you were adopted on or after 1 March 1986

An Oranga Tamariki Adoption Service social worker will offer you counselling and support. However, your pre-adoptive certificate can be sent directly to you if you do not want counselling. To request for your certificate to be sent directly to you:

- in section 4 of this form (BMD451) tick the box to indicate you want your certificate sent directly to you, and
- respond to the letter Birth Deaths and Marriages (BDM) send you after we receive your application to confirm you do not want counselling.

Counsellors appointed under the Adult Adoption Information Act 1985

Under the Adult Adoption Information Act 1985, counselling is usually required before the release of a pre-adoptive birth certificate.

Following is a list of people who are appointed to provide counselling. Counselling can be face to face or by telephone.

Independent counsellors are people in the community appointed by Oranga Tamariki.

Oranga Tamariki have a specialised Adoption Service that can also assist with the release of a pre-adoptive birth certificate


